## Injectable Product of the Year

### Criteria

This award is open to manufacturers or UK distributors of injectable products for the UK aesthetics market. Finalists will be chosen from products that support a wide range of indications and can show evidence of good safety and efficacy, optimum duration and tangible benefits over similar products on the market. This category is only open to products that have been available in the UK for a year or more. If the product launched after 1 January 2020, it is eligible for the Product Innovation award. Companies can enter the same product in both categories, if eligible, but it can only be announced as a finalist in one.

### Entry instructions

You are encouraged to keep your entry concise and clear; bullet points and the use of formatting options such as bold, underlines and italics are encouraged to ensure your entry is easy to digest for judges. Please note that formatting cannot be copied and pasted from Word documents, so you should only add these when submitting your entry on the website. A strict character limit of 1,700 (including spaces) is enforced for each question and you must not exceed this; however, your entry does not have to meet it. References are included in the character count, although you may supply a reference list as part of your supplementary materials if it exceeds the character count. The winner will be selected from the finalists using a combination of Aesthetics reader votes and judges' scores. Voting will constitute a 20% share of the final score.

- Supplementary materials: you may add relevant supplementary materials to your entry such as: videos, images, references, testimonials, statistics etc. They should be relevant to the entry and mentioned in the relevant question it relates to. Supplementary materials which provide extended answers to the questions will be discounted.
- Important: please check your entry carefully for accuracy, grammar and spelling as this information may appear in the Aesthetics journal and on the Aesthetics website, as well as being considered as part of the judging process. Judges will mark down entries that do not answer all questions.
- Amendments and late entries: There will be no opportunity to amend this once you have submitted your application online unless you pay a £100 +VAT administration fee and this information is received before shortlisting has begun. ### Questions

1. Tick to confirm this product has been available in the UK for a year or more.
2. What are the patient indications for this product? What approvals does it hold?
3. Describe the protocol for this treatment.
4. What improvements can patients realistically expect to see and how long will they last?
5. Describe the active ingredients and mechanism of action of the product. Does it include an anaesthetic?
6. Provide details of the peer-reviewed clinical data demonstrating the safety and efficacy of the product? Full references should be provided.
7. Describe developments/innovations that have taken place in the last 12 months.
8. How many clinics use this product? How many new clinics have you added this year?
9. How is the product different to competitors? What is your USP?
